

PORT AUGUSTA REGATTA.

Port Augusta, December 28.

The annual regatta took place to-day. The steamers Adelaide, Nelcebee, and Petrel from Port Pirie arrived with 800 passengers. The train from Quorn brought 250, and the total attendance was about 2,500. The events were not brilliantly contested, the paucity of entries resulting in the races being one sided. The Mayor, Mr. Robertson, acted as Starter and Mr. J. Beaton as Judge. A large number of events were got through. Results:—First-class Sailing Race—Won easily by Mr. Dewhurst's Doris; Second-class do., Mr. Thomson's Spezzia; Maiden Fours, Port Augusta, Port Pirie; Champion Four-oared Race, Port Augusta, Port Pirie—won easily. A four-oared race, married v. single men, resulted in a dead heat. A concert was held in the Town Hall in the evening. There was a large attendance, and it concluded a most enjoyable day's sport.
