The inshore and theory part of this is in Bill Henry's hands, while the offshore portion is the domain of Jamie Cowell.

TL 6 - This is a scheme oriented towards yacht racing of the type with which the Squadron is involved, and although this contains considerable portions of the elements from TL 4, it moves into the area of racing as opposed to cruising.

TL 7 - This is a scheme dealing with sail boards.

As remarked above, the procedure is to identify the area in which you have an interest, obtain a log book, available from the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron office, and have a look through the theoretical and practical syllabi set out therein.

The requirements are not outside the capability of the average person interested in his or her segment of the sport.

NEW PRODUCTS

SAFETY FUEL CANS

A new range of explosion proof fuel containers has recently been released for sale in South Australia. Known as Safety Fuel Cans, they are manufactured in England for Paddy Hopkirk Products, and can be purchased from most retail outlets.

These cans are made from 0.8 mm steel, and the makers claim that they will not explode if exposed to fire, impact flashback, auto ignition, penetration by hot metal splinters or electrostatic ignition. They are filled with "Explofoil", an aluminium heat dispersing mesh which whilst displacing less than 1% of the containers' volume, virtually eliminates fuel surge.

They are available in both 5 and 10 litre capacities, and a plastic screw on pourer is included with each can. Anchor plates can also be obtained for both size cans.
