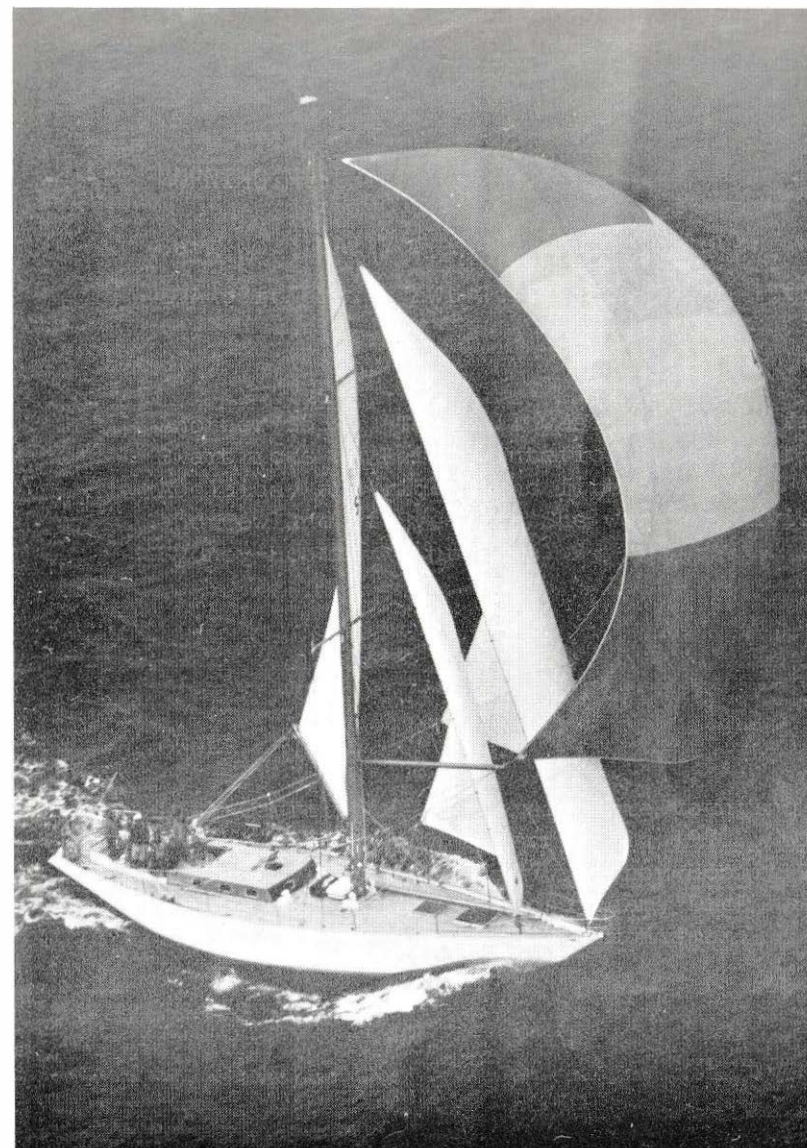
A steel yacht designed by the English Designer Alan Buchanan and built by her owner J. Grubic. She has competed in the past three Sydney-Hobart Yacht Races.

Josko is one of the most colourful personalities and experienced ocean racing skippers in South Australia. He has competed with his own boats in seven Sydney-Hobart and three Queenscliff-Port Lincoln Races (all in excess of 600 miles), and is a consistent starter in R.S.A.Y.S. events.

His previous yachts have been Adria and Marina. In Anaconda he has competed in three Sydney-Hobarts, the Southern Cross Cup and Admiral Cup Selection Trials.

Since Anaconda was dismasted in last year's Sydney-Hobart, she has been given a taller mast, an attempt to improve her light weather performance, yet by careful study of the I.O.R. measurements, her handicap has been slightly improved.
