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The builder, ALan Jordan, raced the boat extensively for nearly 20 years.

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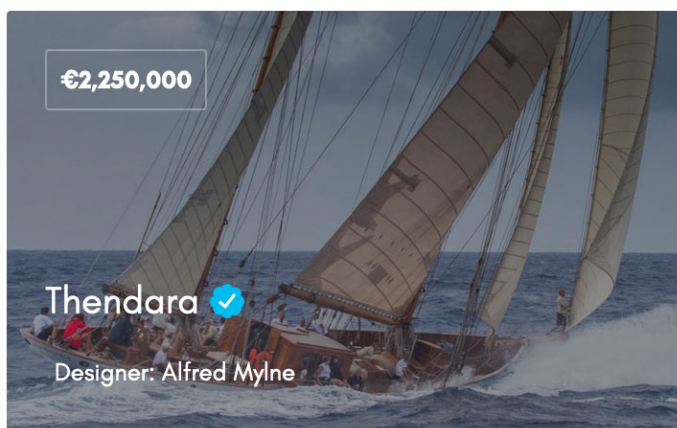
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She went to Sydney in the early 1990's and was acquired by the current owner in 1995 (2009). Since then the boat has had a major re-build with a new rig and engine.
