

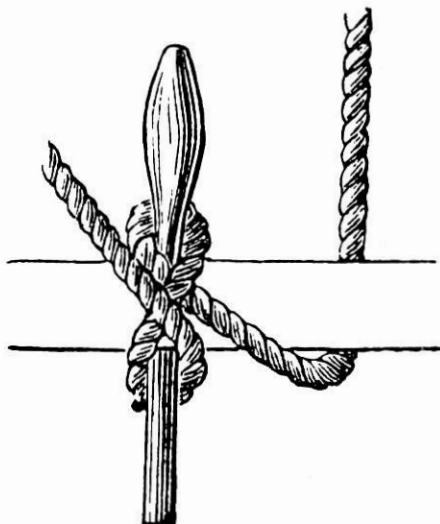
MESSAGE FROM THE COMMODORE
