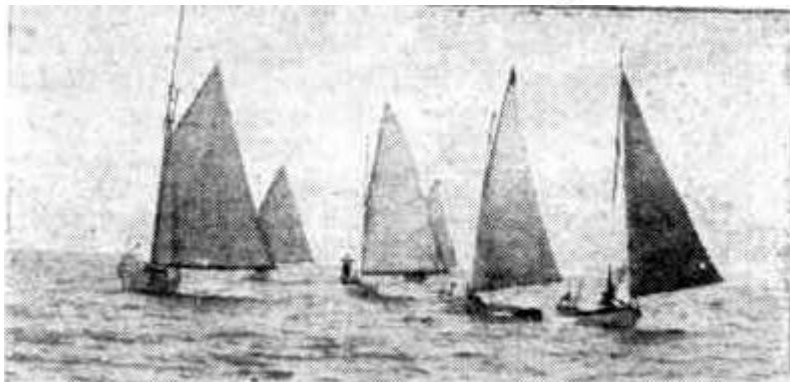

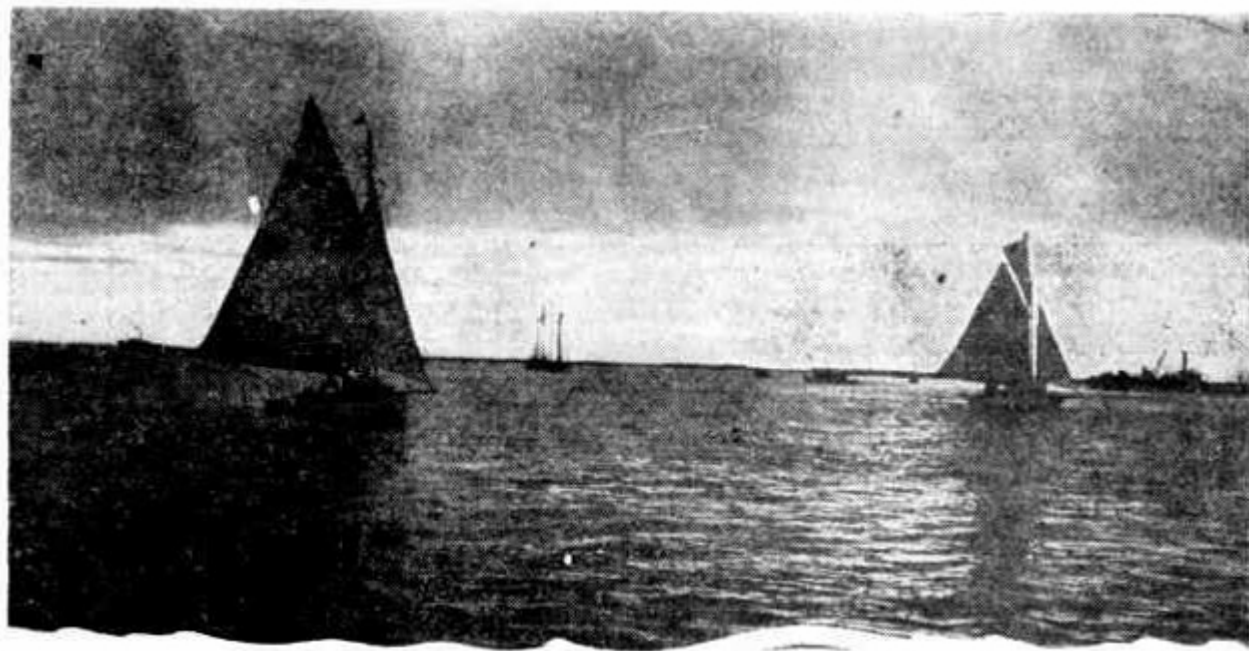

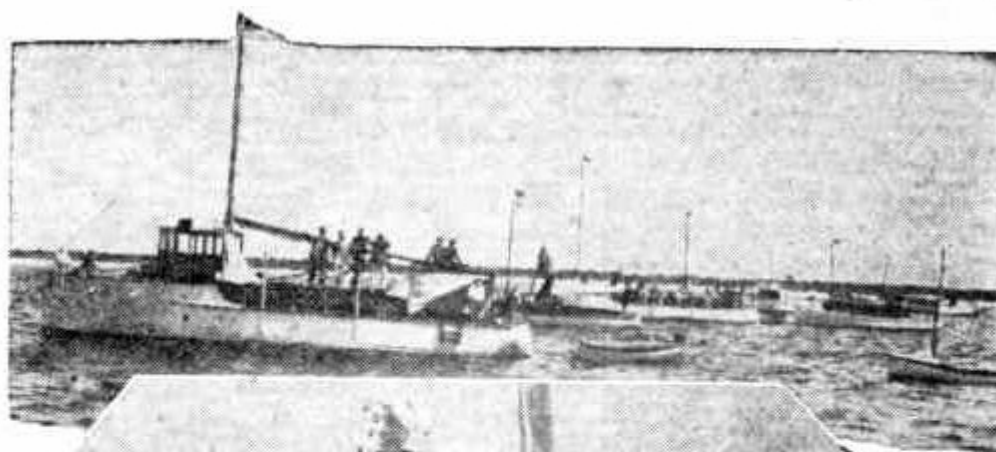

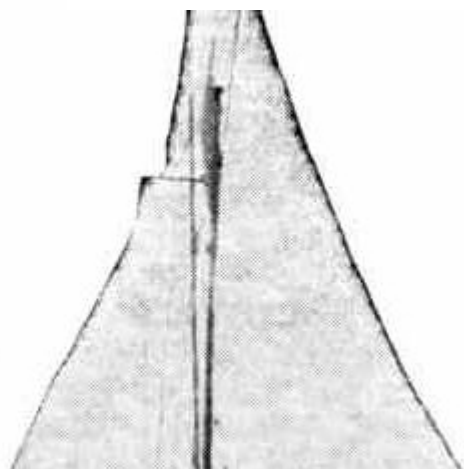


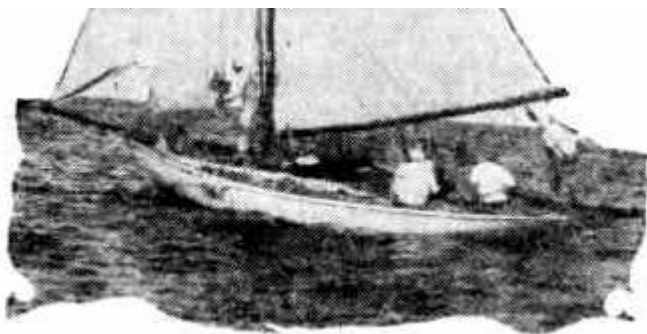
MANOEUVRING at the start of the squadron's annual race across the Gulf to Black Point. The race was won by Dr. Vero's "Solace."
