It is possible that the 1988/89 JOG Nationals could be held in Adelaide. This may seem a little early to start talking about this event but South Australia's chance of playing host very much depends on your support. However it's likely that support for JOG and Adelaide's claim to the Nationals could be put to the test, and JOG's Secretary/Treasurer Wally Rantanen has appealed to all owners of JOG rated yachts to make a show of strength in the meantime by competing in all of their events. The 86/87 Nationals will be held in Melbourne in the first week of January 87. Over 80 boats are expected to compete in this series.

Wally Rantanen says the Organising Committee has applied to the AYF for exemption from the sponsorship rule as occurred for the first time in the Australian National Championships in Tasmania last year. Boats wishing to compete in the Victorian Championships will need to round up their own sponsorship.

Traditional type half ton and other heavy weight JOG rated yachts will be interested to know that there is now an official "heavy weight" formula which Wally says can be obtained from him at any time.

At the State JOG AGM held recently all present committee members were re-elected and the committee expanded by two, to ten. The President is Bob Lawson, Secretary/Treasurer is Wally Rantanen, Keel Boat representative is John Thompson and Publicity, Yours Truly.
