Tenders are invited, returnable 19th February, 1945, to Secretary, Department of the Navy, for purchase of the following vessels lying at the ports shown:—

MELBOURNE

TERRALINNA—Auxiliary Ketch. Built 1922 at Hobart. Length 60ft. Beam 17ft. Draught 5ft. 6in. Tonnage 30/25. Engines Deutz Diesel 65 H.P.

WESTWIND—Motor Yacht twin screw. Length 78ft. Beam 16ft. Depth 9ft. Built 1914 at Williamstown (J. J. Savage). Engines—Two 4 cylinder Gardiner Marine type kerosene engines of 50 H.P. each. Gross tonnage 55.

ALANCIA—Motor Launch. Built 1911. Length 37ft. 2in. Beam 11ft. Draught 6ft. 10in. Engine—44 H.P. Stearns (kerosene).

LADY MADGE—Wooden Motor Launch. Length 41ft. Beam 10ft. Draught 3ft. 6in. Engines—Two Ailsa Craig Petrol Engines.

FOAM—50ft. x 18ft. x 7ft. 6in. Auxiliary Ketch fitted with "Rex" 30 H.P. petrol engine.

HOBART

EDELWEISS—Raised Deck Motor Cruiser Length 40ft. 10in. Beam 10ft. 4in. Draught 3ft. 6in. Built 1938 Gross tonnage 13. Engines—4 cylinder Invincible 25-35 H.P. kerosene engine.

HERMIONE II.—Motor Cruiser. Length 36ft. Beam 9ft. 2in. Draught 3ft. 6in. Built 1914/15. Gross tonnage 12. Engines—Parsons 25-45 H.P. 4 cylinder Marine petrol engine.

PORT ADELAIDE

CYGNUS—Power Cruiser. Length. 54ft. Beam 13ft. Draught 3ft. 9in. Built 1938. Gross tonnage 30. Engines—Two 8 cyl. Gray Marine petrol engines 125 H.P. each.

Forms of tender may be obtained at Navy Office, Victoria Barracks, St. Kilda Road, Melbourne (Shipping and Transport Accounts Section), and from the Naval Officer-in-Charge at ports of Melbourne, Hobart and Port Adelaide, and from the representative of the Commonwealth Disposals Commission in capital cities.

Tenders should be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed Secretary, Department of the Navy, Victoria Barracks St. Kilda Road, Melbourne, and endorsed "Tender for the purchase of . . ."

Inspection may be arranged with the Naval Officer-in-Charge at the port where the vessels lie.
