

All Aboard

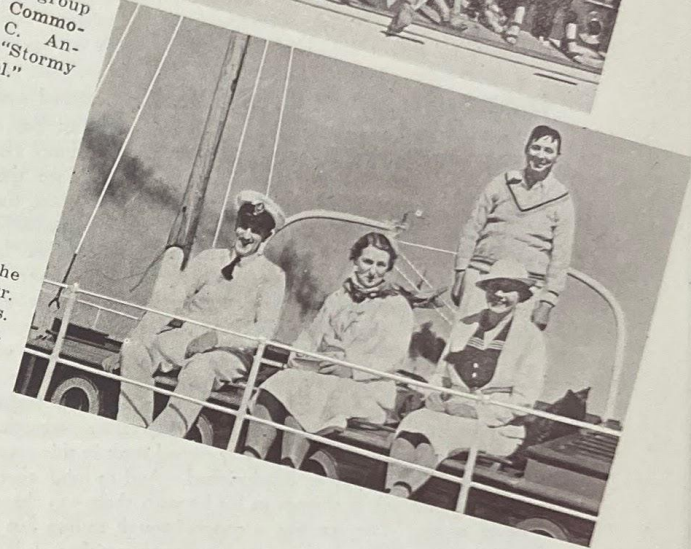

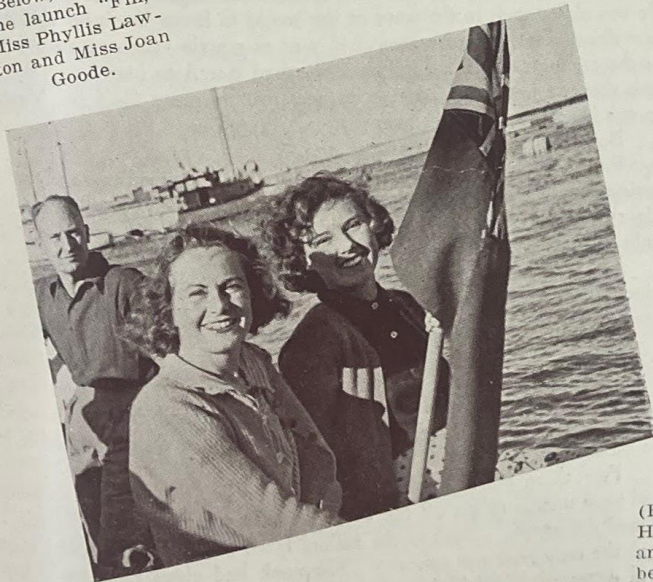
