

SYDNEY ANNIVERSARY REGATTA.

SUNBEAM WINS THE YACHT RACE.

SYDNEY, March 18.

THE Anniversary Regatta, which was postponed from January, was brought off to-day in fine weather. The yacht race for the 30-rating class was won by Sunbeam, Janet being second, and Magic third.

With the exception of Janet, the yachts all got away quickly. Sunbeam gradually crept up on the Fleetwing on the run to Manly, rounding the buoy in third place. Squaring for home, Sunbeam ran away from the others, and led to the finish. On comparing times, Sunbeam won with 1m. 57s. to spare from Janet.

[Sunbeam, the winning yacht, was built by Logan Bros., of Auckland, to the order of Mr. A. T. Pittar, but was subsequently sold to Mr. Fred Doran, of Sydney. Janet, the second boat, was built by Mr. C. Bailey, jun., of Auckland, to the order of a Sydney yachtsman; Magic, the third boat, is an English-built yacht.]

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
