

Death Of Mr. J. F. Bennett

Mr. J. F. ("Fred") Bennett who died yesterday in his 80th year, at his home at Seaview road, Tenyson, held every important position in the SA National Football League and was a life member.

Mr. Bennett was chairman of the North Adelaide Football Club for over 20 years and was a State selector. He was also a delegate to the Australian National Football Council, and a member of the Royal SA Yacht Squadron.

Until his retirement in 1938, he was secretary of A. M. Bickford & Sons, Ltd., for about 40 years.

His funeral will leave at 3 p.m. for the Centennial Park Cemetery. Mr. A. Kenny will attend on behalf of the ANFC and the SA National Football League will be represented by the secretary (Mr. T. S. Hill) and delegates.
