

N.A. FOOTBALL IDENTITY DIES

Mr. Fred Bennett, 79, who died at his home at Seaview road, Tennyson, today, was an identity in South Australian football.

He was connected with the SA Football League for more than 40 years, and filled all the important posts open to club delegates.

He had been a State selector and a State representative on the Australian Football Council.

He was a keen worker for North Adelaide Club, and was chairman for more than 20 years.

He was a member of the Royal SA Yacht Squadron, and took a big interest in junior sport.

Mr. Bennett, who was single, joined A. M. Bickford & Sons, Ltd., in 1887, and was secretary for about 40 years until retiring in 1938.
