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.....The yacht Magic, recently bought by a South Australian syndicate, has arrived at Adelaide from Sydney, after a very hazardous voyage. Leaving Sydney on August 15, she soon had a fierce gale, and after passing Montagu Island, the sea swept her decks. After replenishing the water-tanks at Twofold Bay, the yacht made Cape Otway on the 22nd ultimo, and a violent gale sprang up that necessitated heaving to for 12 hours. Captain Mountifield resolved to run back to Apollo Bay. The yacht was just preparing to make fast to the mooring buoy when a whole gale set in, a single anchor was let go with a long scope of cable, at which the yacht rode, although every moment it was expected that the cable would part. The second anchor

was kept ready for letting go, but so close was the Magic to the rocks that it would have been of small service. The gale moderated sufficiently at last to allow her to get underway, when she made a good run along the land, covering 131½ miles in 12 hours.
