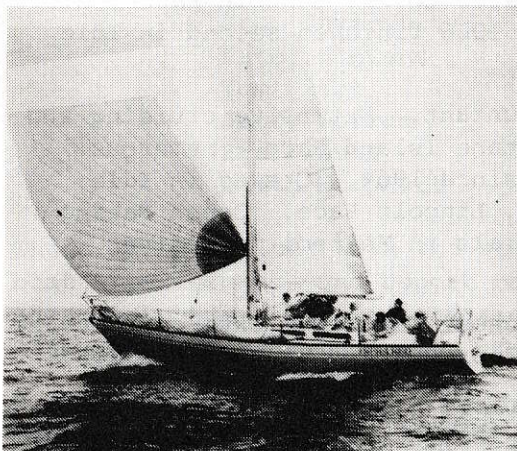


SAILING COMMITTEE

ADRIA
