
Yacht Nautilus Sold To Victorian

Mr. Gavin Viner Smith, of St. Peters, who returned to Adelaide by the express yesterday, was one of the members of the crew of the Nautilus, the 23-ton yacht which was recently taken to Melbourne by its former owner, Mr. Frank Verco.

The new owner of the yacht, Mr. Fred. Warner, of Melbourne, told Mr. Viner Smith that he intended to enter the yacht, which he will rename the Tarni, in the New Zealand trans-oceanic race.

The crew of the Nautilus had a most adventurous voyage, said Mr. Viner Smith, and the time for the 490 miles was 85 hours. Heavy seas and cold rains were encountered.
