

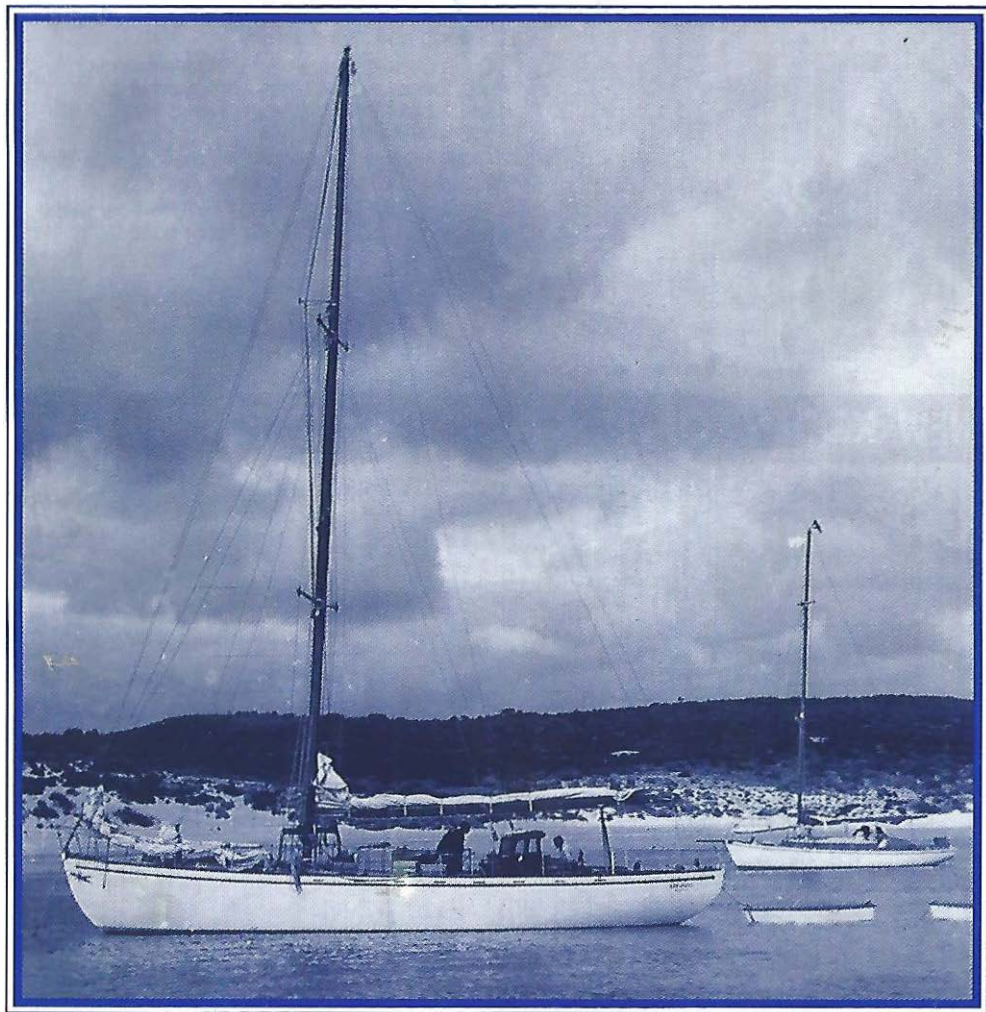

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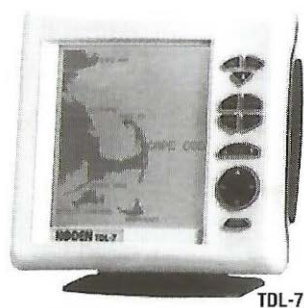
Many features include alarm and 12-ranges from 1/8 - 16nm.



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Cover Photograph: Squadron vessels *Seevogel* and *Norallie* anchored in Whaler's Bay, Thistle Island while returning from the inaugural Adelaide-Port Lincoln race, February 1950. *Seevogel* carried deck cargo for the Wade family, who farmed the island at that time. The homestead and shed, the only buildings on the island, are just visible behind the yachts.

Seevogel, owned and skippered by Wesley Harris, a Nuriootpa dentist, carried the sail number SA1, which has passed to *One & All*. She was the pride of the fleet in those days.

Norallie, which was built by B. Weir in 1906 for L.W. Walter was owned by Captain Frank Duplock, a former officer of the British Army, who served in West Africa and in India. He came to Adelaide to retire and to fulfil a lifetime ambition to sail on his own yacht. He raced the vessel for many years. He was well known for his birthday parties, of which he had several each year. On these occasions he invented a new cocktail, with devastating results. He was a very colourful character. (Bryan Price)
