Skippers must also maintain a sound knowledge of the racing rules and their boat's handling characteristics to avoid dangerous situations developing on the water.

A final word on volunteers. This club, and particularly the racing, cannot operate without

competent volunteers who conduct races, take times and calculate the results every week. The Sailing Committee urgently requires some additional volunteers who are prepared to help in these areas of race administration. If you want to help but are not sure of what's involved, just ask. My thanks to the Sailing Committee, the OOD John Ellison and his crew and to Helen Prisk and Roger Oaten who compile the results and get them on the Net each week. Special thanks also to retiring Committee members Bill Strangways and John Moffatt who have each served for 12 years or more on the Sailing Committee.
