MR. BUNDEY'S NEW YACHT.

On Saturday afternoon Mr. Justice Bundey's new cutter yacht, *Pastime*, was out on a trial trip in the Port river. The boat has lately been built to Mr. Bundey's order by Mr. H. Chant. She measures 40 feet overall, with a finely-shaped counter, 8 feet 6 inches beam, and 7 feet 6 inches depth of hold. The planking below the water-line is of jarrah, while all the top sides are of huon pine and teak, the deck is of kauri, 3 by 1½ inches, laid with a sweep, following the shape of the boat, commencing at the outside—instead of running straight—the old fashion. The boat is about ten tons yacht measurement, and is intended for a cruiser. Her sailing did not quite come up to expectations. She carries a good bit of canvas, and will no doubt show better sailing powers in a sou'-westerly breeze. Mr. Justice Bundey, after cruising about in the river during the afternoon for some time, headed the boat for her moorings.
